- Highlight what makes you the best fit for the role to which you applied.





The Business and Professional Women (BPW), St. Kitts collaborated with the Ministry of Health, and the St. Kitts and Nevis Medical and Dental Association to administer a 'Women's Wellness Clinic' during the month of January, World Cervical Cancer Awareness Month. This was the third year the club has organised the Women's Wellness Clinic, after a hiatus due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Four clinics were hosted at health centres across St. Kitts every Saturday for a month.

In addition to Cervical Cancer Screening (pap smear test), the nurses also conducted breast examinations, blood pressure testing; height, weight, and body mass index; diabetes screening as well as rapid testing for HIV.


